After Surgery

Pred-Gati-Brom \rightarrow Instill 1 drop four times a day in the surgical eye(s) day of surgery and taper as follows.

Post Op Instructions

- Do not rub your eye vigorously for 1 month after surgery.
- Normal activities are fine as long as you do not hold your breath.
- No swimming for 1 week.
- Do not wear eye makeup for 3 days with soluble mascara or for 1 week if non-soluble mascara.
- You can take a shower tomorrow, (keep your eyes shut while washing your face).
- Wear your shield while sleeping (for 1 week).
- Polarized sunglasses are recommended when outside.
- Use eye drops as instructed and continue any previously prescribed eye drops; for example, cataract drops. Resume all regular medications.
- You may use preservative free artificial tears for dryness or discomfort as often as needed. Please wait 3 minutes before or after using postoperative eye drops.

PLEASE USE PRESERVATIVE FREE ARTIFICIAL TEARS AT LEAST EVERY HOUR WHILE AWAKE FOR THE FIRST 2-3 DAYS AND AS NEEDED FOR DISCOMFORT.

- Your surgeon may request for you to use Hydroeyes vitamins and Restasis or Xiidra twice a day.
- While healing your vision may be blurry for several days but, should gradually improve daily.
- You <u>must</u> call immediately if any of the following occurs:
 - 1. You get a headache that is not relieved by over-the-counter pain relievers, such as Tylenol or Ibuprofen.
 - 2. You have a steady flow of tears that does not stop.
 - 3. Pain with movement
 - 4. Sudden loss or sudden clouding of vision
 - 5. Flashes and Floaters
